Fall Festival Success

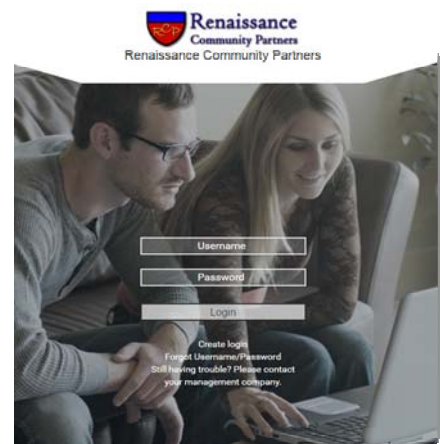
