## Lock Your Car Doors


Please remember to lock your car doors when you go inside for the evening. When car doors are unlocked it makes them an easy prey for burglars.

### Set up Automatic Payment on Portal

Our Portal software has just released a new option to set up automatic payment (ACH/EFT) directly through the portal system. In the past to set up automatic payment through your bank account homeowners would need to send a form into Renaissance with a voided check, but this system will make setting up automatic payment even easier.



When you login to your account on portal you will see an option on the menu "ACH/EFT". If you click that option on the left you will see an option to "Setup New ACH/EFT Plan". If you click that button it will pull up the box below for you to enter your bank information.

As our assessments are due quarterly on the 1<sup>st</sup> (January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1) make sure you set your start date PRIOR to the due date of the quarterly assessment. If you set your start date for April 2<sup>nd</sup>, then it won't pull for the April assessment and your payment would be late.


