

Manage Your Compliance


You can view any open violations and see violation photos and letters.

Easily see your account history and pay your bill. Just click on Accounting and see your history, and click on Pay to pay your bill. Click print to print your account history.




VANDALS STEAL SOLAR LIGHTS AND BACKFLOWS IN COMMUNITY

A few weeks ago, vandals stole hundreds of dollars in landscaping equipment from the community, including backflow valves and solar lights. Parkwood Ranch residents are encouraged to report vandalism to the Mesa Police Department. An easy way to do this is to download the Mesa PD app.

In addition, the application allows two way communications using Twitter, Facebook, and a special feature for submitting anonymous tips to the Department. CCRS RESTRICT RV/TRAILER PARKING IN PARKWOOD RANCH

Parking RVs, boats and other vehicles of this type along the street blocks visibility and hampers emergency vehicles as they respond to calls. The Parkwood Ranch CCRs restrict the parking of these vehicles in section 4.3y:

"Trucks, Trailers, Campers and Boats. No motor vehicle classed by manufacturer rating as exceeding 1-ton, mobile home, recreational vehicle, travel trailer, tent trailer, trailer, camper shell, detached camper, boat, boat trailer, or other similar equipment or vehicle may be parked, maintained, constructed, reconstructed or repaired on any Lot or Parcel or on any street in Parkwood Ranch so as to be Visible From Neighboring Property..."
